

Third Grade

Quantity

- A minimum of thirty minutes per night, Monday-Thursday (Parents need to use their discretion as to the maximum amount of time spent on homework each night.)
- Ten minutes of the thirty minutes should be spent on studying spelling words and/or math facts
- Occasionally extended projects will be assigned and additional time will need to be budgeted.

Grading

- Homework will be checked and recorded for completion and quality
- Homework of poor quality will need to be redone for full credit
- Each homework assignment will be graded as either a check or a zero
A check means the assignment was completed satisfactorily
A zero means the assignment was not turned in on time/partial credit will be given for late assignments.
- Homework will be averaged as a test grade
For example, 8 assignments out of 10=80%

Consequences

- Homework that is not completed will receive a zero. It will be the student's responsibility to complete it during the day (for example, snack time, free reading period).
- Each term the students will be given one chance to forget an assignment at home without being penalized. The homework should be brought in the next day for full credit. After that one chance, all other rules apply. (The student will receive a zero and need to complete the assignment during the school day).
